Adoration: 139 Tantum Ergo 888 green (first verse - in Latin - start singing right away - Father will lead)

*Change over to Stay Here and Keep Watch (instrumental) while Fr strips the altar.*

Closing: 502 Stay Here and Keep Watch with Me 411 green (sung 2x) - followed by instrumental (of another song) while greeters are dismissing
