Most of choir head downstairs after Communion - Cantor/Small Group & piano stay in choir loft to lead Hail Our Savior's Glorious Body - BRING WORSHIP AID!!!

Blessed Sacrament (Father kneels at altar in silence - followed by instrumental)

Procession of Blessed Sacrament (start when Father stands and starts walking): Choir process to Parish Hall (Order of Procession: Servers, Deacon, Choir (as they can get in), People, Father). In Parish Hall stand front right (by the statues). Hail Our Savior's goes until Father leaves church.

509 Hail Our Savior's Glorious Body (verses 1-4 in English)

(do not announce) *(start when Father gets up all move - Choir follows Deacon into Parish Hall, goes to the front right)*

139 Tantum Ergo (in Latin)

(do not announce) Start as soon as sacrament placed in the tabernacle, give pitch, choir lead

After a period of Silence, Father will ask the congregation to ...let us remember the words of Jesus to "Stay here and Keep Watch with Me..." That is the cue to start - pitch, then begin...Following the song there will be a brief silence, then once the servers and Father leave, the choir can silently process out
