- Accessibility entrance: side door from Weston St. (near tabernacle)
- Seating: follow directions of Greeters
- Dismissal: exit immediately as directed by Greeters

**Receiving Holy Communion**

- Follow directions of Greeters
- Allow physical distancing
- Remove/lower mask
- Receive in the hand (Please have palms and fingers straight/flat to allow minister to place the Host without making contact)
- Consume Host in front of minister
- Replace mask on return to pew

**TV Mass:** The Saturday 4 PM Mass is broadcast live on KQEG and rebroadcast on Sunday at 10 AM.

**Online Mass** 4 PM Mass will continue to be live streamed on our website, our 7:30 AM weekday Masses will be live streamed on Tuesdays and Thursdays (except Aug. 13). If additional volunteers come forward for training, we will be able to continue this valued service. This ministry requires a bit of tech savvy to operate our AV system and our YouTube channel. ## *Catholic Christian Outreach*

**MMOC Small Faith-Sharing Groups** As Catholic Christians, we are called to a deep, personal relationship with Jesus Christ. In Him we find our freedom, purpose, and peace. Are you feeling a desire for a deeper connection with the Lord in daily living? Then consider joining a Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO) faith-sharing group. These groups of 5-8 people meet weekly to review and discuss topics over a 36-week period. The CCO Faith Study series is a collection of helpful resources to clearly and simply explain truths and principles for living the Catholic faith. Each lesson integrates Scripture and Church teachings in its small group discussions.

This journey makes a difference:

*"When I started the small group sharing, I thought 36 weeks would be a long time. I was unsure about sharing my thoughts and feelings about Faith, because I always viewed it something 'personal and private.'*

*"Prior to the class, I knew the name of every person in the group. Now I really KNOW them, and I know that – even though we all have very different lives – we are united in a special way on the same journey to Heaven. AND, I know we are all willing and eager to help others find answers to faith questions as well as ways to live the life God wants for us.*

*"Before CCO, I knew there were three persons in one God. Now, I know how each one is interested in my welfare, plays an important role in my daily life, and wants to help me find the way to eternal life. I find myself thinking about them from time to time throughout the day. They are now PART OF MY LIFE ... not just words on a page. My prayers still include the ones we memorized as kids, but they also include the questions and observations of my soul ... and I consider them in light of God's design. I suppose one could call this contemplation.*

*"Before CCO, I could provide the words that answer the question, 'Why did God make me?' and I believe that is still helpful to keep me centered. But, now I also know in my heart as well as in my head, that He is counting on me to bring the answer to the rest of the world, and that the Holy Spirit is ready to lead and guide me along the way.*

*"Before CCO, I knew that the Catholic Church is important in shaping our society. Now I know we are in great need of the church on all levels of our lives, and that as individuals we have an obligation to help others find Christ and experience redemption.*

*"After CCO, I am experiencing less anxiety, and more peace ... even with COVID and riots!*

*"I have a better, richer understanding on where God fits into my life.*

*"My prayer life is bigger and deeper.*

*"My mind turns to God throughout the day.*

*"I am finding Scripture to be more rewarding and meaningful, because it was part of our learning experience; and, I now believe it to be more relevant to my life.*

*"I see my role as a Catholic Christian as being more than sending kids to CCD and going to Mass on Sunday.*

*"I have acquired 7 wonderful, faith-filled friends who bring smiles to my face and joy to my life.*

*"Spending these hours in a deep relationship with like-minded, devoted Catholic Christians has given me comfort and confidence. I feel more complete.*

*"Now that we have come to the end of this segment of our faith journey, I don't want it to end...*

*"I want to hang onto the dear souls who made this journey with me, who shared their doubts and insights and cheered me on.*

*"I am looking for ways to stay connected to these wonderful groupmates. Undoubtedly, this will lead to more activity in our parish.*

*"Thank you for the opportunity to take part in this program. I am more convinced than ever that we need more adult education. This program was the most meaningful I have participated in because it went deeper than watching a video and giving a five-minute response. We challenged, fed, and nurtured each other through the whole program.*

*"I am committed to making this program available to all adults in our parish ... and to bringing it to young adults who will have a long time to benefit from it.*

*"I also look forward to seeking opportunities to further God's kingdom in the world, outside of the walls of our church."*

## Building Our Future Together

The use of Scrip is an effective and easy way to help raise funds for Building Our Future Together, or to give the parish a financial boost, or to obtain tuition assistance at Aquinas Catholic Schools or MMOC Religious Education for your own family. And, the best part is it doesn't cost you anything! Nothing!

Purchasing a Scrip card from MMOC is like purchasing a gift card. For example, if you purchase a \$100 Scrip card to Festival or Kwik Trip you get the full \$100 in purchase power. The vendor, Festival or Kwik Trip (for example), give a rebate to the parish. You may designate where that rebate goes – to help pay your child's tuition at ACS, to help pay your child's Religious Education tuition at MMOC, to benefit the Building Fund, or to benefit the parish general fund. It's as simple and easy as that!

The following is a brief financial recap of Scrip activity in the fiscal year ended June 30:

The total amount of Scrip sales from July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020: \$832,171

From those sales, the parish received rebates of \$47,869 – about 5.75% of the sales.
