## Guidelines for Mass

### 7:30 AM Mass

- Masks are required; extras are in gathering space
- Doors are unlocked by 7 AM
- Four Entrances: center doors across from Trane parking lot; both side doors from Weston St., and Parish Hall doors
- Seating: two center sections
- Dismissal: lower kneelers and exit immediately
- Use church restrooms only

### Weekend Masses

- Masks are required; extras are in gathering space
- Doors are unlocked 30 min. prior
- Entrances: main doors across from Trane parking lot and Parish Hall doors
- Accessibility entrance: side door from Weston St. (near tabernacle)
- Seating: follow directions of Greeters
- Dismissal: exit immediately as directed by Greeters

### Receiving Holy Communion

- Follow directions of Greeters
- Allow physical distancing
- Remove/lower mask
- Receive in the hand (Please have palms and fingers straight/flat to allow minister to place the Host without making contact)
- Consume Host in front of minister
- Replace mask on return to pew

## Catholic Christian Outreach

**MMOC Small Faith-Sharing Groups** As Catholic Christians, we are called to a deep, personal relationship with Jesus Christ. In Him we find our freedom, purpose, and peace. Are you feeling a desire for a deeper connection with the Lord in daily living? Then consider joining a Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO) faith-sharing group. These groups of 5-8 people meet weekly to review and discuss topics over a 36-week period. The CCO Faith Study series is a collection of helpful resources to clearly and simply explain truths and principles for living the Catholic faith. Each lesson integrates Scripture and Church teachings in its small group discussions.

This journey makes a difference:

"Reflecting on the journey, I believe all the series of books helped me to solidify my relationship with Jesus. I feel honorably humbled. I thought I was a good Catholic and felt that I had a good relationship with Jesus. This series brought to surface emotions and curiosity that I have never experienced before. I am so thankful that I have a merciful God and that he loves me for who I am. God put together this fantastic group of ladies in my life. Without knowing it ahead of time, my group was meant for me. Our experiences and our need for Jesus grew deep. God knew, and He put us together."

"I have noticed a difference in my prayer life. It came to light the last day of daily public Mass before the pandemic restrictions. I am not one to regularly attend daily Mass, but for some reason, I felt that I needed to be there. I had a feeling in my heart that I needed to be with Jesus in the Eucharist. See, this journey has helped me to understand that this tug in my heart is Jesus speaking to me. Before this series, I was not clear as to what that feeling was, but I understand now that it is Jesus. He is telling me to be silent and to listen to Him. See, as I thought the world was coming apart, I took great comfort in being at Mass, being with Jesus. I left Mass with a powerful calm feeling and knew that I would be ok and so would my family. During the state closure when we were not able to attend Mass, I found comfort sitting in the church. I would read the bible and be present. This is the most significant change in my prayer life. I have found the greatest peace and comfort in being closest to Jesus in prayer and in the church. I have learned to read the bible and listen to the words that Jesus has for me. I discovered on this journey that I needed to mend specific points in my relationship with Jesus. One night in my reflection, it occurred to me in Matthew 26:36-46 that God asked Jesus to do tough stuff, die on the cross for our sins, but God had a much better plan, eternal life with Him in heaven. I am not alone in my struggles. Jesus knows, and He loves me."

"This is an amazing experience. I gained a deeper relationship with Jesus. I gained friendships that are supportive and share in the same love for Jesus. At the end of every study, we present prayer intentions, how powerful, and what a supportive feeling knowing that you have a friend praying for you and with you."

"I do not look at this study as a 36-week commitment. I look forward to every week; I love to learn and grow in my relationship with Jesus. I find my group comforting and supportive. It is exciting to be able to talk about my love for Jesus and know that the ladies that I am with feel the same excitement. It will be sad when we part from our weekly routine, but I know that we are all just a phone call away and that I will see them at Mass." – Christine K.

"This whole program has been very enlightening to me; it has brought me closer to my faith and Christ. It has given me a feeling of closeness to the other ladies within our group and the ability to talk freely amongst them. This class made me look deep within myself and sort out my feelings, which at times was very uncomfortable. The end result brought me closer to Jesus and a better understanding of the Trinity and the Catholic Church. I was introduced to many other avenues that are available to enrich me in my journey, i.e., Blessed is She, Formed, podcasts, and music. It has reintroduced me to the Bible again which I have enjoyed reading. Although I always felt I had my faith, I really didn't realize what I was missing like having Christ becoming more the center of my life. I am continuing to work on my trust with Jesus and am much closer than I was last Fall. I don't know where I would be in my grieving process, if I didn't have the support of my faith and this group with the loss of my husband this past year. I was pretty angry with God over what my husband was going through...and then his death. I learned in this class God has a plan for each of us, but I just couldn't imagine why His plan for my husband included the suffering he went through towards the end. By turning to God, I came to realize that His plan was that he wouldn't have to suffer any longer and wouldn't have to go through Covid-19. I am convinced my husband wouldn't have survived through it and would have had many complications and more suffering. Because of this class and being more open with Christ, I now thank God for sparing him from it all, as well as him no longer suffering. I think knowing I am never alone and that Christ and the Holy Spirit are always with me, is a great comfort to me. The booklet on the Holy Spirit probably impressed me the most in realizing that He is always there and guiding me, I enjoyed those lessons the most."


