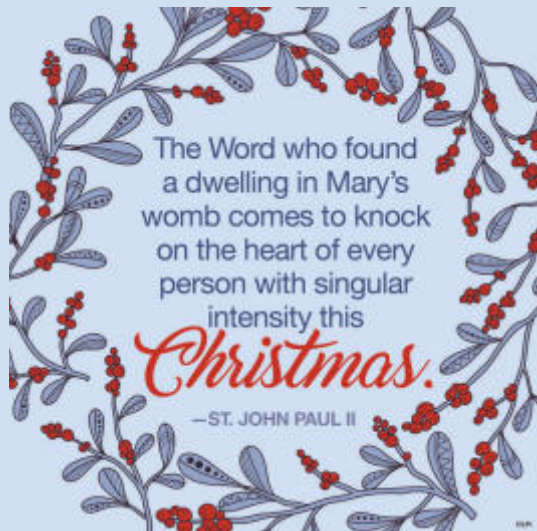

Building Our Future Together

On December 3, we had a construction project Walk Through with Fowler & Hammer, Buchner Plumbing, and Poellinger Electric. The electrical and Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning work is coming to a close. At that time there remain a few items to be addressed including some insulation to be installed around new pipes, a couple of dampers to be installed, a few remaining holes to be filled and old pipe stubs to be removed, and a final wall hung heating unit installation in the main sacristy. The major item remaining was final control work for the HVAC equipment as well as for the new lighting in church. The controls for the HVAC is the most technical as the operation will be computer guided. The new lighting in church is dimmable and capable of offering a number of options for different lighting scenes. To obtain the optimum performance, the control work for both the HVAC and lighting may take additional weeks and possibly spill into January. Buchner's will be back in the spring to initiate the air conditioning equipment. The weather has gotten too cold for them to be able to start the equipment and coordinate the temperature and a demand for cooling.

Mary, Mother of the Church Parish has gone through three phases and well into a fourth phase of new construction and renovation. It has been an amazing accomplishment and we are so grateful and proud of the generosity of our parishioners.

Here in La Crosse, our sister parish of the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman is just beginning a \$6.1 million, multi-phase project to address some dramatically needed repairs at our Diocesan Cathedral. For example, the scaffolding and nets surrounding the steeple at the Cathedral are in place to "catch" stone that occasionally falls from the steeple. Last Sunday a general appeal was made to all parishioners in the Diocese to participate in the *Christ Our Cornerstone* campaign for the Cathedral repairs and renovations. St. Ambrose Financial Services of the Diocese of La Crosse has pledged up to \$3,000,000 for the project. The campaign fundraising is three-pronged: the Cathedral Parish, the Clergy of the Diocese, and the Diocesan-wide appeal to all parishes. We are fully aware of the financial challenges it requires to undertake major projects. When we began our projects, we were most grateful that our parish received some gifts from non-parishioners, former parishioners, and alumni of our parish schools. Because of its nature, a Cathedral Church is uniquely tied to us all. Prayerfully consider your financial response to the *Christ Our Cornerstone* campaign.

Our Advent time is turning to Christmas and the celebration of the birth of our Lord. Please remember to pray that God will continue to bless our parish family as we Build Our Future Together!
