

April is Child Abuse Prevention Month. What is happening in the diocese to prevent abuse?

- Training is provided for all adults and youth to identify warning signs and develop strategies for maintaining a safe environment for all.
- A designated Victim Assistance Coordinator is available to receive reports and accompany victims through their journey.
- •A volunteer independent Review Board assists the bishop in the review of cases and makes recommendations for moving forward.
- •A Safe Environment Coordinator assists parish and school personnel with training and back ground screenings for anyone who may have access to children.
- An audit is conducted by an independent firm to evaluate implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. Findings are incorporated with those of other dioceses and made available in an Annual Report.

According to the CDC, one in seven children have experienced child abuse or neglect in the past year. If you or someone you know is being abused call 911 or contact or your state child protective services. It is the responsibility of all persons to protect children and the vulnerable among us, "whoever receives one child such as this in my name receives me" (Matthew 18:5).

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR RE-PORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the

diocesan website at :diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the diocesan website. 
