

Parish Kevs/FOBs

The church security system has been installed as well as FOB sensors at 6 doors. Security has become a more prominent issue in our world in the last few years. To ensure security, MMOC has a Key/FOB Policy. When necessary, MMOC will issue keys or FOBs to those who need it for a specific ministry at MMOC. Keys or FOBs will be issued under the following conditions:

- To be issued only for specific tasks related to ministry such as unlocking/locking for scheduled meetings.
- Not for personal use.
- At the end of a ministry assignment, keys will be returned to the parish office.
- For those needing keys throughout the year, keys will be issued on an annual basis so they will need to be re-issued on an annual basis.

The Parish Office will keep track of the keys/FOBs through a Facility Key Agreement form and recognizes this will be an inconvenience, but security is a priority. Everyone with a key or FOB is asked to visit the office before July 31 to renew the agreement or return the key(s)/FOB that are no longer needed.





Buildings and Grounds Update

The shed addition will be wrapping up within the next 2 weeks. Siding was installed last week by Fowler & Hammer. La Crosse Glass Company installed the 16' garage door last week. Poellinger Electric will finish the electrical this week. Along the north wall - soffit lights were installed for security eliminating the need for the security light on the wall which in the past invited birds to nest above. Coulee Region Mechanical will install/finish both hose bibs this week. Due to the lengthy duration of no precipitation this will be a nice addition to help nurse our young trees along. Next week, Fowler's carpenters will connect the new addition to the original shed (opening the existing wall). As soon as the opening is created, the countertop on the west wall will be installed. The Toolcat's attachment industrial racking will be installed. Fowler & Hammer will complete the shed's site concrete next week. AB Seamless will install the gutters upon the completion of the site concrete. Lastly, Winona Nursery will add soil and seed along with adding the landscaping to the west end of the shed.
