### CCO Small Faith-Sharing Groups

As we set our eyes on the life of Christ and His mission, we are learning that we need a relationship with Him – a close and personal relationship. Are you asking yourself, “How can I have a personal relationship with Jesus? What does it entail?” Perhaps you also are experiencing some uncertainty about “going on mission” and what that means in your life. You are not alone in these questions!

Catholic Christian Outreach can help! Over the past five years, MMOC has offered this dynamic and life-changing faith study series as an opportunity to grow in relationship with Jesus Christ and fellow Christians. Over 36 weeks, you and 4-7 other group members will explore, discuss, and deepen your relationship with Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church. You will discover the joy and freedom of letting Jesus be your primary relationship – your center.

Every human heart desires to be known, loved, and cared for – this is what every great relationship offers us. Perhaps it is experienced with your spouse, close friend, or sibling. However, a relationship with Jesus is a gift no other relationship can fully provide. When we enter into a relationship with Jesus Christ, we find that He knows, loves, and cares for us in abundance. In fact, He said, “I have come that they may have life, and have it more abundantly” (John 10:10). Once we experience this relationship, we desire to share it with others – we seek to go on His mission.

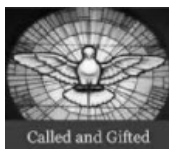
### Two Minutes with Jesus for Eucharistic Revival

1. Does Jesus understand everything about me? Jesus knows exactly what you are feeling and understands. Where you are, Jesus has been; He shares every joy and every pain with you. Let's pray this right now and every day this week: If you have something painful in your heart, speak with Jesus about it and give it to Him. This week, read from Scripture how the angel appears to Joseph and guides him to take his wife Mary into his home in Matthew 1:18-25. Note: Mary and Joseph were married in the Jewish tradition, which is referred to as being betrothed. There are 2 parts to betrothal: marriage and then, after one year, sharing a common home.

2. Jesus wants to stay with us always. Jesus loves each one of us so much that He gives Himself to us in Holy Communion at Mass. We receive Jesus Himself. When the priest prays the words of Jesus over the bread and wine at Mass, they are no longer bread and wine but the Body and Blood of Christ. Jesus gives Himself to us because He wants to stay with each one of us always. Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Jesus, thank You that You desire to stay with us always. This week, read from Scripture about the birth of the Christ Child in Luke 2:1-7.

Are you seeking to know Jesus Christ more deeply or understand God and His plan for us more fully? Do you want to know why Catholics believe what they believe and do what they do?
