

Faith Formation

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a program for the religious formation of children rooted in the Bible and the liturgy of the Church. In this program, the 3-6 year old child will encounter Jesus as the Good Shepherd; who loves them, cares for them, and knows them by name. This is accomplished through prayer, listening to Scripture, and giving the child time to work with hands-on materials. Each of the materials presented are linked to either a specific part of the Mass or the Bible, which help to make the mystery of God concrete for the child. To participate, children must be at least three years old by November 1, 2023. Space is limited to 10 children per session. Registration is \$50 per child. If this is a burden, please reach out!

Eucharistic Revival

Two Minutes with Jesus for Eucharistic Revival

1. Jesus is truly present in the Holy Eucharist. When we look at the consecrated Host at Mass, our eyes see only bread, but the reality is we are looking at Jesus truly present. Jesus, grant me the grace to believe this truth, that though "hidden", You are truly present in Holy Communion. It is important to remember that what we are not able to see with our eyes, we grasp by choosing to believe – with faith's consent. Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Lord, I want to believe. Please help me to believe that what You say is true, especially helping the part of me that sometimes questions. This week, read about the father of a sick boy who asked Jesus to help him believe what seemed impossible in Mark 9:20-27.

2. Jesus wants us to know He is continually with us. Oftentimes, our mind begins to wander at Mass because we only see bread and wine. What contributes to our distractions is the bombardment of noise and images on our mind that come through our physical senses (hearing, seeing). Therefore, we are much less attuned to the world of the spirit and the much deeper spiritual realities that are right here, all around us. Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Jesus, help me to learn to be quiet and reveal to my heart the truth that this is really You present under the appearance of bread and wine. This week, read about Jacob in the desert, who was very much afraid, and came to realize that God was

present right there with him. As with Jacob, we can say as we pray before the Blessed Sacrament, "Surely the Lord is in this place, and I did not know it." (Genesis 28:10-17)

Welcome, Deacon Terry Bell!

Welcome? YES! Perhaps an explanation is appropriate.

The Bell family joined the parish in 2016, so we don't need to welcome them to the parish!

When Deacon Terry Bell was ordained on May 7, 2022, he was assigned to MMOC by Bishop Callahan to be "our deacon." Therefore, we don't need to welcome him as our deacon!

However, last summer, the hope was to welcome him as a full-time staff member with an emphasis on adult faith formation and evangelization. This was the ministry he had been doing for eight years among college students through FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) – two years at UW-Platteville and 6 years as a Team Director at UW-La Crosse.

In prayer, I was convinced Deacon Terry Bell would be a graced fit for our new parish vision: **His Life. His Mission. Our Focus.** I approached him about full-time status a year before ordination. He deeply desired to join parish staff but needed to pray about it. After months of discernment, he believed God was calling him to remain with FOCUS. In our conversations, I came to learn that FOCUS sends missionaries into parishes. He felt called to help FOCUS in its newest venture — to parishes — and he hoped MMOC would be willing to make this happen.

You see, the majority of FOCUS's campus mission-aries are in their 20's. Frequently enough, their next chosen occupations are in parishes, Catholic Schools, and non-profit organizations. Established in 1998, FOCUS noticed this trend. Likewise, FOCUS learned from the university graduates they served that it wasn't always easy to connect with a new parish once they left campus. There was a need in parishes for bible studies and other forms of small groups that supported their Christian discipleship journey.

So, FOCUS began to expand their areas of service to parishes in 2015. They started slowly and learned from their pastors, their experience, and – of course – the Holy Spirit. Parishes are stable communities, unlike the university student bodies, so the way they supplemented parish life needed to adapt as well.

Hiring a FOCUS missionary was worth discerning, especially if it were Deacon Terry Bell. He was already well known to us as he assists at our Sunday Masses...frequently standing among the last to leave church. Also, his monthly homilies reveal the time and prayer he devotes to us. They are marked with wisdom and humor, encouragement and challenge, big ideals and practical suggestions... GOOD NEWS!

My communication with FOCUS began in late-2021 and picked up steam in early 2022. In the Spring of

2022, the parish prepared to welcome two FOCUS missionaries per their standard agreement: one male and one female. We would hire both for the low cost of \$64,000 because they provide the rest of the fundraising outside of our parish to cover their salaries and benefits. The parish had an increased stewardship drive to reach this financial goal.

Regrettably, the agreement with FOCUS did not begin as planned on Sept. 1, 2022. Time ran short and they wanted Deacon to assist with some national initiatives. FOCUS operated in good faith and "donated" 15 hours of Deacon's 40-hour work week to MMOC without any cost to the parish. In gratitude, we made a \$3,200 donation to FOCUS. (I chuckle as I type this because Church ministry is never limited to 40 hours! And so it must have seemed to Deacon.)

In the last year, he led a series called "The Search," facilitated a men's CCO faith-sharing group, piloted a new initiative called Discipleship Group, and prepared monthly homilies.

Some weeks ago, Deacon began full-time! We are one of 13 parishes to hire a FOCUS missionary. He has expanded his ministry, especially as our RCIA/OCIA Director, which already has 9 adults, 2 teenagers, and a child who are learning about the Catholic Faith.

Regrettably, FOCUS was unable to find a female counterpart to propose as a good fit for our parish, so we will wait and pray for a qualified individual to fill this position on Sept. 1, 2024. In the meantime, MMOC will pay FOCUS \$32,000 this year for the benefit of Deacon Bell's full-time ministry among us.

Next week's bulletin will share his faith journey, but it's worth mentioning here that he and his wife Johanna are raising 5 young daughters. He has two vocations. So, he needs to strike a balance and – like all of us – set some healthy boundaries. Currently, he limits the evenings that he works on parish commitments to 2 per week. He also regularly assists at our 2 Sunday Masses and also assists at the 4 PM Vigil on the weekends that he preaches so that most Saturdays can remain "family days."

So... "Welcome, Deacon Terry Bell!" ...as a FULL-TIME parish staff member...and a missionary among us!

Every one of us is called to become a missionary disciple, for Jesus not only came to give us abundant life, He also wants us to multiply His life in others: "Go...make disciples." I look forward to learning from Deacon Terry Bell.


