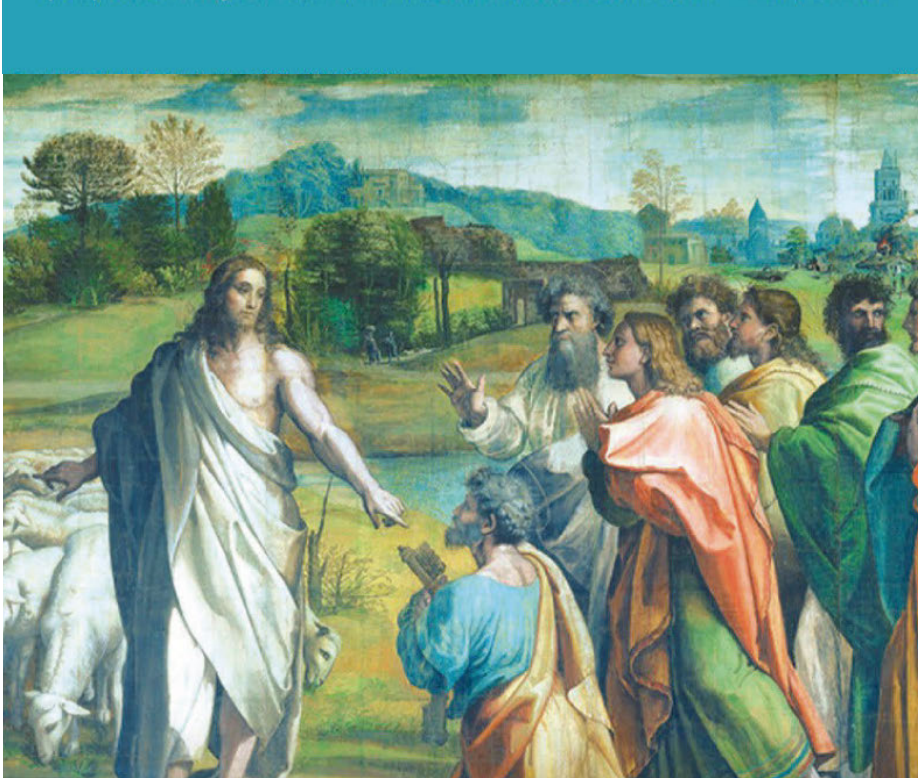

## Advent: A Time of Preparation

This year, the season of Advent begins on Sunday, December 3. Advent is the four weeks we set aside for preparing our hearts before the annual celebration of Christ's birth on Christmas. The Incarnation – God becoming man – is the turning point of history. Our Heavenly Father loves us so much that He promised to send us a Savior after the Original Sin of Adam and Eve. And He kept His promise. The Son of God was born in Bethlehem to give His life for us on the cross so that our sins can be forgiven, so that we “may have life, and have it to the full” (John 10:10). This preparation during Advent is to include interior penance, which involves a conversion of heart toward God and away from sin. Let us take Advent seriously by taking more time for prayer, offering small sacrifices for peace in families and the world, and receiving the Sacrament of Penance.

## Eucharistic Revival

### Two Minutes With Jesus

1. The Holy Eucharist is Jesus Christ, really and truly present.

At the consecration of every Mass, the priest prays the words which Jesus Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is My Blood." The bread is no longer bread, and the wine is no longer wine. We receive Jesus Himself as nourishment for our souls. This week read these words of Jesus every day: "Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day" (John 6: 54).

2. Our Response is Thanksgiving.

When we receive Jesus, we want to thank Him for the total gift of Himself to us. This Gift of the Eucharist empowers us to live our lives with thankful hearts as we follow Him with trust and commitment. Let's read and pray this right now and every day this week: We have a Heavenly Father who loves each one of us, in an absolutely unique way as expressed in Scripture: "Every good and perfect gift comes down from the Father of lights, with Whom there is no variation or shadow caused by change" (James 1:17). In thanksgiving, let us pray the Our Father prayer.

### Rebuild My Church: The Crib

Jesus asked St. Francis of Assisi to "Rebuild My Church." Francis wanted to connect people with the humanity of the Son of God: the Incarnation. 800 years ago - in 1223 - St. Francis arranged a "living nativity" for people.

The Diocese of La Crosse relies on St. Francis as our secondary patron and is highlighting this anniversary with a new prayer: "The Crib" prayer.

Many of us look at the world - and even the Church - with any number of reactions: uncertainty, fear, anger, contempt, or apathy. The Nativity story has answers for all of these experiences! May our reflection on "The Crib" be an opportunity for each of us to let down our defenses and trust with the vulnerability of the Christ Child. May we all be surprised by joy as were Mary, Joseph, the Shepherds, the Magi, and the angels. May we be open to the good plans God has for us.

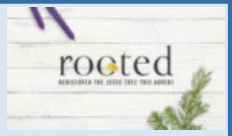
Each week of Behold will focus on a different theme that you can connect to your life in a practical way:
