### Lenten Collection

Did you know? 12 schools in the La Crosse school  
district operate food pantries for their students & nearly  
half of the students in the school district of La Crosse  
receive free or reduced meals.

The Hunger Task Force serves our community as a  
food bank. As a food bank, they collect, sort, and dis-  
tribute food to various meal sites, shelters, and food  
pantries, like those in the La Crosse School District.  
These food pantries then serve individuals and their  
families by distributing food items to those in need.

In 2000, The Hunger Task Force began their Food  
Recovery Program to prevent safe and wholesome food  
from going to waste. Through this program, The Hunger  
Task Force coordinates donations from approximately  
520 donors and food drives and then delivers to over  
120 meal sites, food pantries, youth programs, and out-  
reach sites in La Crosse, Vernon, Trempealeau, Mon-

roe, Houston, Winona, and Allamakee Counties. In  
2022, the Food Recovery Program "recovered" 2.5 mil-  
lion pounds of food!

Each year, up to 1/5<sup>th</sup> of America's food ends up as  
waste – approximately 130 pounds per person going  
into landfills. The annual value of this food is \$31 billion  
– roughly enough food to feed 49 million people! This  
program reduces waste in our landfills, uses the earth's  
bounty well, and provides for needy families.

The Hunger Task Force Food Recovery Program is a  
FREE and LOCAL service. They rely solely on grants  
and committed donors. Please be generous this Lent to  
our chosen charity: The Hunger Task Force.
