## The Answer Eucharistic Rally

The Answer Eucharistic Rally that will be held this Friday on June 7 is a unique event for the Church in La Crosse. This experience will be life-giving and life-changing and through your participation we will see a long-term revival in people that will affect families, parishes, and communities.



The day starts with a Eucharistic Procession from 500 Company Store Road beginning at 10 AM and crossing the Cameron Street Bridge as Bishop Barron from the Diocese of Winona-Rochester will transfer the Blessed Sacrament to Bishop Battersby at the corner of Cameron and 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets. The procession is an occasion to profess our faith in the sacrament of the Eucharist, to thank Jesus for the gift of His cross, and His presence in this sacrament. It provides an opportunity for people of all generations to join in the Eucharistic Procession as we journey together to the La Crosse Center where we will immediately enter into Mass.

Confessions will be heard throughout the day and evening and the event will culminate in a Holy Hour of Adoration beginning at the main arena with thousands in attendance. Come for the whole day or just a part of it. You won't be disappointed!

While the use of public transportation is encouraged, paid parking is available at any of the downtown parking ramps. A free shuttle bus service from the La Crosse Center will be available in the morning to take participants over to the starting point of the Eucharistic Procession.

Concession stands will be available beginning after Mass and throughout the day or evening. Outside food and drinks cannot be brought into the center but you can leave for part of the day and return providing you are wearing your wristband. Vendors and other displays will be located throughout the center

Please continue to get the word out in these next few days! Your invitation will make all the difference in a person saying "Yes!" to attending.

## Shrines of Italy Pilgrimage

June 2, 2024

In September 2025, we will embark on a pilgrimage to the Shrines of Italy. Last week's bulletin article highlighted the first leg of the core pilgrimage: Assisi. This week, we will focus on our time in Rome. Pilgrims will return to Rome on the evening of Oct. 5. After dinner, we will be able to walk to St. Peter's Square to pray the Rosary.

On Oct. 6, we will tour St. Peter's Basilica, where we will view Michelangelo's Pieta sculpture and pray at the tombs of Pope Benedict XVI and St. John Paul II. Next, we will visit the Vatican Museum, where we will see the Tapestry Gallery, Raphael Rooms, and Sistine Chapel. After lunch, we will continue down the Appian Way to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls and the Catacombs.

Oct. 7 begins with a walking tour from St. Peter's Square to the ancient part of Rome, including Castel Sant'Angelo, Piazza Navona, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps. Our next stop is the Trevi Fountain area for some free time. In the afternoon, we will visit the remaining major Basilicas in Rome: St. Mary Major and St. John the Lateran. We then cross the street to the very steps that lead up to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem which Jesus climbed on His way to trial during his Passion. Holy Mass will be celebrated at the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the oldest of the four major Basilicas.

On Oct. 8, after an early breakfast, we will leave by motor coach to the airport for our return flights home.

### Catholic Charities: Warming Center

A convergence of grace! The Warming Center is open during the six "cold months" of November - April. During the pandemic, federal grants were available to keep the Warming Center open during office hours, not overnight. When the funds ran out, so did this program.

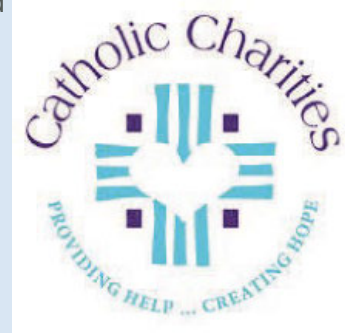
During the last "cold season," Kevin Decker (staff at Cathedral Parish) offered a bible study for men on Thursday mornings immediately following the exit of the overnight guests. The majority of the guests are men. This added the Spiritual Works of Mercy to the Corporal Works of Mercy. Kevin found that this helped the small group of men to remain clean and sober. He wanted to maintain this support during the summertime and this became the impetus for grace.

The Warming Center is open for showers and laundry services (with 2 new washers & 2 new dryers purchased by Roncalli Newman and Blessed Sacrament) on Tuesdays and Thursdays this summer. Their hours will be 8-10 a.m. and 1:30-3:30 p.m. both days. Currently they have about 8-10 clients for each shift and they expect that to grow. The Catholic clergy of the La Crosse Deanery are fully funding one day (May - Oct) and our parish

Men's Club and PCCW are fully funding the other day. Each day costs \$5,200. Also, our Matthew 25 group who gathered on Thursday afternoons to make dinners, breakfast items, and sandwiches, are getting together on Thursdays to make lunch and snack items.

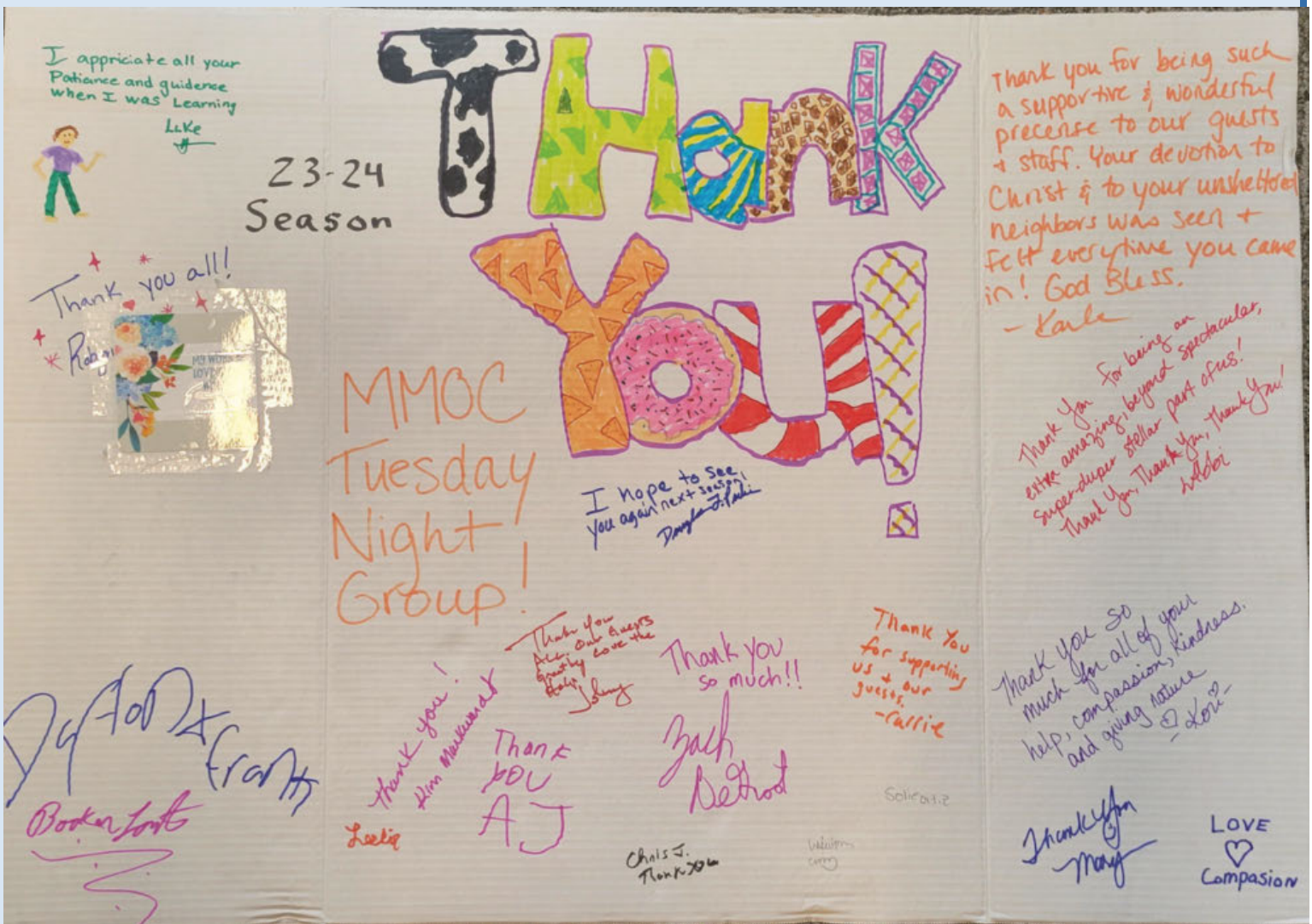
