

2025 Italy Pilgrimage — Pre-tour

In 2025, a Jubilee Year: Pilgrims of Hope, we will head to Italy! In addition to our pilgrimage to the Shrines of Italy, pilgrims should consider signing up for the pretrip to Florence and Venice.

The journey begins from the US on Sept. 25 to Venice. We stay in Padua, which honors St. Anthony, "Patron Saint of Lost Things and Causes," and includes Mass at his Basilica and a visit to his tomb.

On Sept. 27, we visit Venice, the "city paved with water," which consists of a walking tour of St. Mark's Square and the Golden Basilica of San Marco, which is known for the great mosaics that depict the Old and New Testaments of the Bible, and the afternoon for free time to explore Venice with a late return to Padua.

On Sept. 28, we visit Florence, the birthplace of the Renaissance and home to some of the most renowned artists: Dante, Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Raphael, Botticelli, and Donatello—an art lover's dream place. We will view the famous sculpture of Michelangelo, David and much more. On Sept. 29, a walking tour includes the Church of the Holy Cross, Piazza Signorina, and much more. You will have the afternoon free to explore Florence.

On Sept. 30, we go to Siena, the birthplace of St. Catherine of Siena, a Doctor of the Church, and St. Ber-

nadine, the Apostle of Italy. We will enjoy lunch, a walking tour, and some additional free time before meeting the rest of our group in Assisi.

Pilgrims are accompanying Jesus from city to city, lighting hearts on fire along the way with all four branches of this historic Pilgrimage converging in Indianapolis for the 10th National Eucharistic Congress. Over 30,000 people have registered for the Congress, which will be held July 17 - 21, 2024.


