## Part Time Housekeeper Needed

Accordingly, we are accepting applications to hire a Finance Assistant. Duties include:

- -Prepares payroll to be submitted to a third-party vendor
   -Reconciles parish bank accounts monthly with a third-party vendor
- -Working with the Pastor to prepare financial reports, the annual budget, the annual Report to the Bishop and the annual Report to the Parish
- -Prepares annual Contribution Statements to Parish Households
- -Assures accountability for the Scrip Program




